
5 Ways to Prepare Instruction for Summer Learning





Liftoff Adaptive Intervention

Students take diagnostic tests within the program and are provided with an individualized learning plan called My Galaxies. Personalized Instruction



Add Additional Subjects

Teachers can add additional subjects to the class where the student is enrolled. This will apply the additional grade-level subject to all students in the class. If the teacher does not want to add an additional grade-level subject to all students in a class, then a separate class can be set up for a small group of students where the subject areas need to be added.

Students can work towards mastering their previous grade-level standards.





Create Custom Tests & Assignments

Teachers can create custom tests and assignments in the assignment center and differentiate practice to individual students that need reinforcement on specific state standards. Teachers can then download reports to track mastery of the standards to further differentiate instruction.
