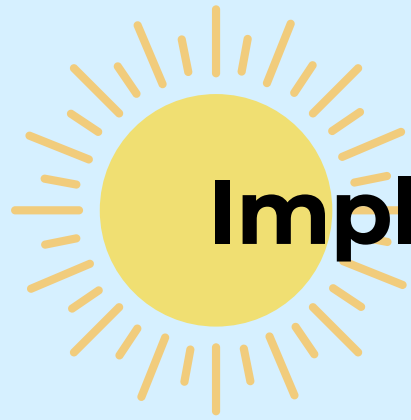

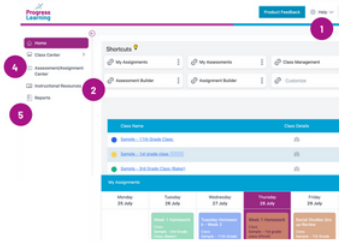

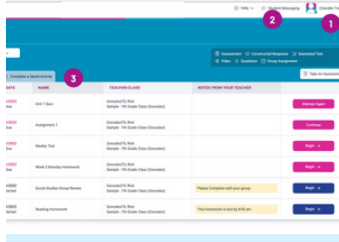

ASSESSMENTS

- Have students visit their Study Plan and take a practice summative or domain test
 - *Optional* - Set a Self-Assessment Schedule
 - Have students take a medium length test mid-summer
 - Set a schedule for the Domain Specific Tests
