

# Student-Led Summer Practice

Guide students to take ownership of their learning and prevent the summer slide with structured, self-paced practice.

## ASSESSMENT

- Direct students to their Study Plan to complete a practice summative or domain assessment.
  - *Optional: Provide a suggested self-assessment schedule to keep students on track.*
- Assign a **pre-built assessment** to establish a starting point and measure growth.



## GO GREEN

- Encourage participation in the **Green Dot Challenge**.
- Guide students to focus on turning pink, yellow, and gray dots green to build mastery.



## INSTANT REMEDIATION AND INTERVENTION

- Assign **Quick Click Remediation** to target individual learning gaps.
- Have students review Progress Reports and set personal learning goals.
- Encourage consistent **Liftoff** practice (grades 2–8) for adaptive intervention and skill development.



## LAST 1-2 WEEKS

- Assign beginner-level practice aligned to upcoming grade-level skills.
- Have students review or print their progress reports to reflect on growth and set goals for the new school year.
  - **Elementary.**
  - **Secondary.**

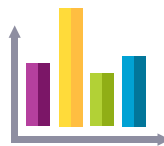
## INSTANT REMEDIATION AND INTERVENTION
