1 My Study Plan

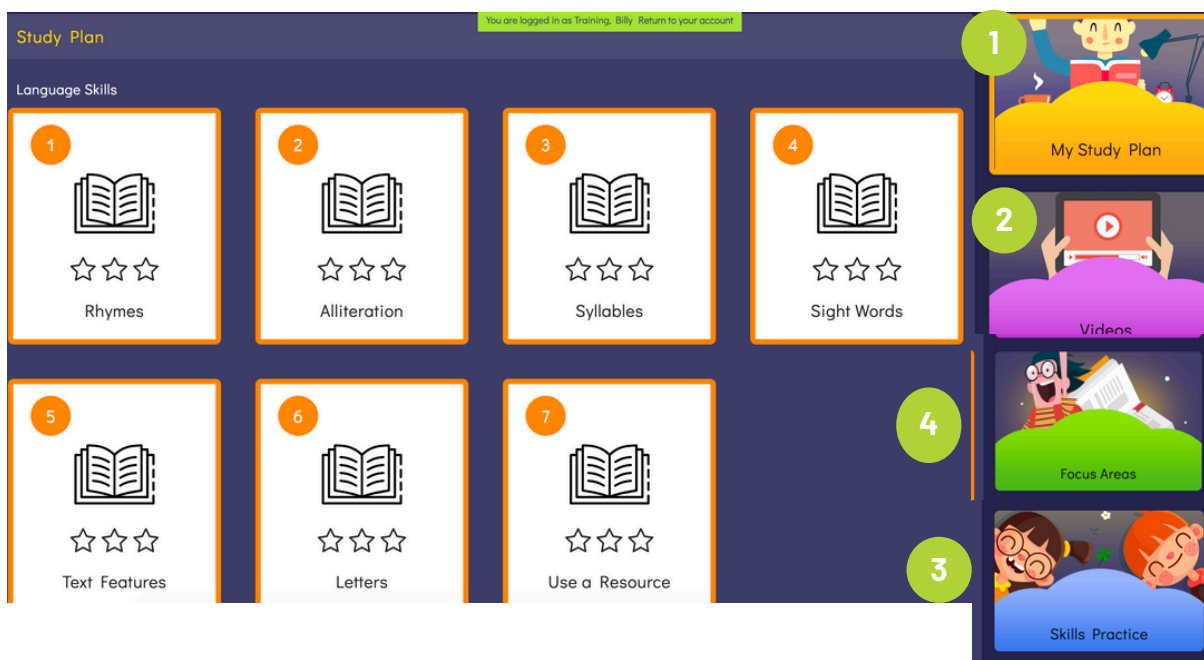

3 Skills Practice

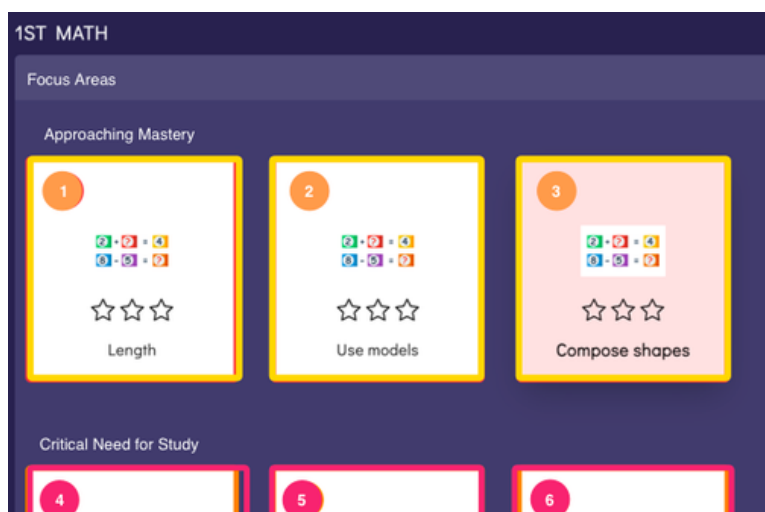
Students can practice fact fluency skills in math and reading. Students will reinforce practice by racing against another student to answer the question correctly and quickly.
