

### 1 Game Arcade


Students in Grades 6-12 earn tokens for the work they complete in Progress Learning and they can use the tokens as currency to purchase access to the Student Game Arcade.

### 4 Graded Work

Click on Graded Work to access results for all your completed activities. You can see how you did on a specific activity by clicking the "View" button. For areas where you scored less than 80%, you can access additional practice to work on attaining a green dot!

### 5 Study Plan and Focus Areas

Study Plan allows you to work on videos and questions based on the subject and standard you've selected. You can practice in subjects you are currently studying, or practice in subjects not currently assigned to you in "Additional Subjects." Focus Areas are individualized learning plans that identify which standards students need further practice on. These standards will be identified in pink as Critical Need for Study or yellow as Approaching Mastery.

### 6 Skills Practice (6th-8th Only)

Skills Practice allows you to review and practice fact fluency and skills in math and reading. You will reinforce practice by racing against another student to answer the question correctly and quickly.

## Study Plan

The Study Plan screen of the platform allows you to work on a variety of activities – videos and questions based on the subject and standard you've selected. You can practice in subjects you are currently studying, or you can practice in subjects not currently assigned to you in "Additional Subjects."

### 1 Practice Subject Tests

Click on the "Practice Tests" icon to take summative tests without your teacher assigning them to you.

### 2 Click on a Standard

Choose a specific standard to begin various review activities on your own. In order to complete an activity, you must earn 80% or higher on practice questions to mark the activity as complete. Track your progress for activities on this page with the Practice Progress bar on the right. You'll earn a badge when you complete all activities in a standard.

Any standard that is 'yellow' means Approaching Mastery, while any standard that is 'pink' means Critical Need for Study.
