

Proctor Mode + Live Monitoring

Secure Testing. Real-Time Visibility. Greater Control.

Proctor Mode and **Live Monitoring** work together to create a more secure, streamlined testing experience in Progress Learning. Students complete assessments in a secure testing environment while teachers, testing coordinators, and administrators monitor progress and respond to issues in real time—all without browser extensions, software downloads, or additional IT support.



PROCTOR MODE

Proctor Mode is enabled on individual assignments, giving educators the flexibility to add an extra layer of assessment security whenever it's needed.

When Proctor Mode is enabled:

- Students are notified that they are entering a secure assessment.
- Assessments launch in a secure full-screen environment.
- If a student leaves the secure testing environment, the activity is automatically locked and the teacher is notified.
- Teachers can quickly unlock students through Live Monitoring or by using an optional Proctor Mode PIN.

 **Proctor Mode**

Proctor Mode is a secure browser experience that opens the activity in full-screen mode. If students attempt to leave the screen, they will be locked out of the activity until you unlock them via Live Monitoring or on their screen using a created pin.

Enable Proctor Mode

Require full-screen mode and lock the activity when students leave the window.

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Proctor Mode Pin (Optional)

Type in a PIN that will be used to unlock the activity from the student's device if a student leaves their Full Screen. The PIN must be exactly 4 digits.

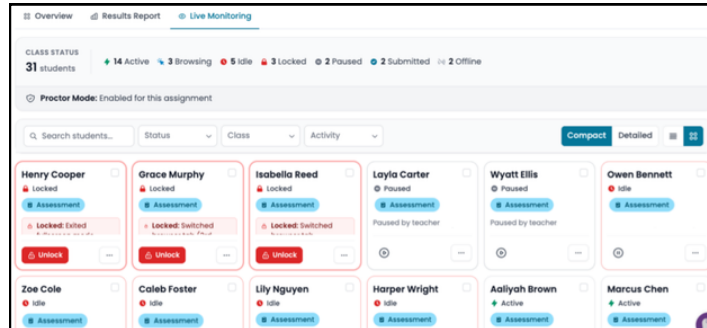
Important: Proctor Mode should not be used at the same time as another lockdown browser or secure testing tool (for example, GoGuardian or Kiosk Mode). Using multiple tools designed to secure the testing environment can cause conflicts and may result in students being locked out of their assessment. Progress Learning recommends testing Proctor Mode within your environment before administering assignments to students.

LIVE MONITORING

The enhanced Live Monitoring dashboard gives teachers and administrators real-time visibility into active assessments, making it easy to monitor progress, identify students who may need assistance, and take action when needed.

From a single dashboard, educators can:

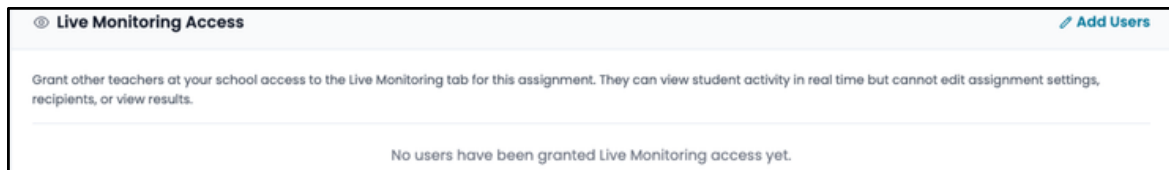
- View student progress and testing status in real time.
- Monitor active, paused, idle, and locked sessions.
- Pause, resume, submit, save and exit, or discard student sessions.
- Unlock Proctor Mode activities with a single click.



NEW: Share Live Monitoring Access

Extend Live Monitoring beyond the classroom by giving additional educators access to active testing sessions.

- Share Live Monitoring access with teachers, testing coordinators, administrators, and grade-level teams.
- Allow multiple educators to monitor the same assessment simultaneously.
- Support campus-wide testing and common assessments without sharing assignment editing permissions.
