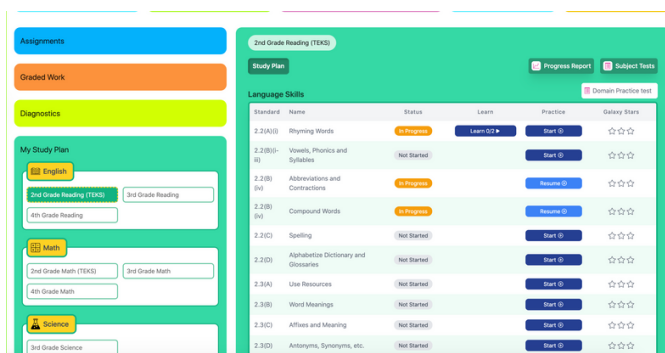


# Elementary Student Platform

## (2nd-5th Grade)




Let's take a look at the elementary Progress Learning platform.



### Study Plan for 2nd-5th Grade

Teachers can assign other grade level Study Plans to specific content areas to provide remediation or acceleration based on individualized student learning needs. Students can videos to review the standard prior to beginning the 10 questions randomly selected to check for mastery of the standard. 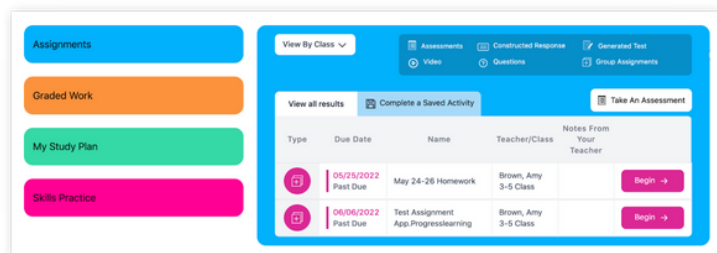

### Focus Areas in the Study Plan for 2nd-5th Grade

Focus Areas are individualized learning plans that identify which standards and skills students need further practice on. These standards will be identified in red as Critical Need for Study or yellow as Some Study Required. This Focus Area individualized learning plan will be a culmination of activities from assignments, assessments, and practice from the Study Plan.

### Current Assignments

Students can also easily track their due dates, notes from their teacher on the specific assignments, or access saved assignments in progress.



### Graded Work from Assignments

Students can access results for all completed activities and filter by teacher/class, subject or dates. Students can also filter their view to display their results on assigned activities only, or limit them to independent practice results.
