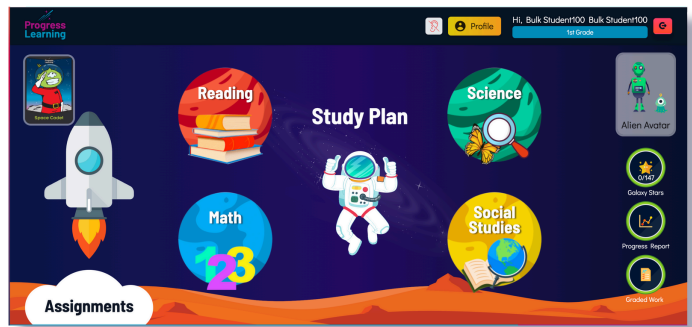


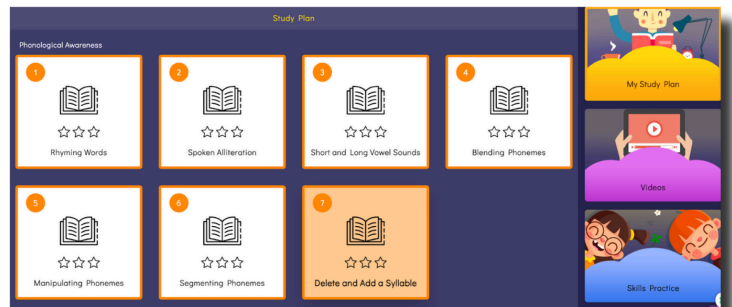
The Science of Reading

Study Plan

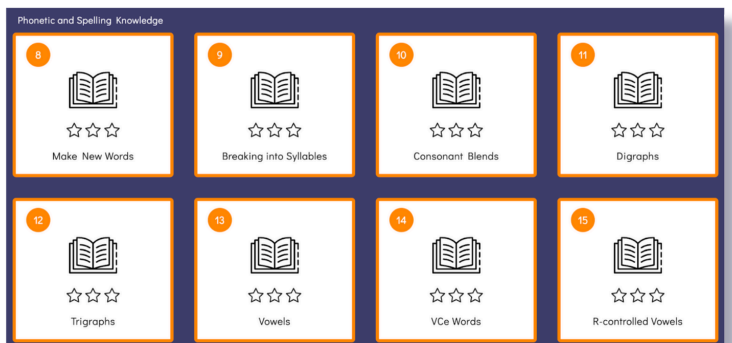

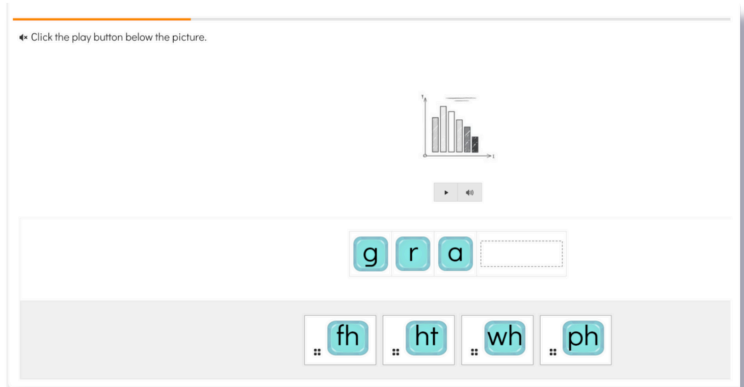
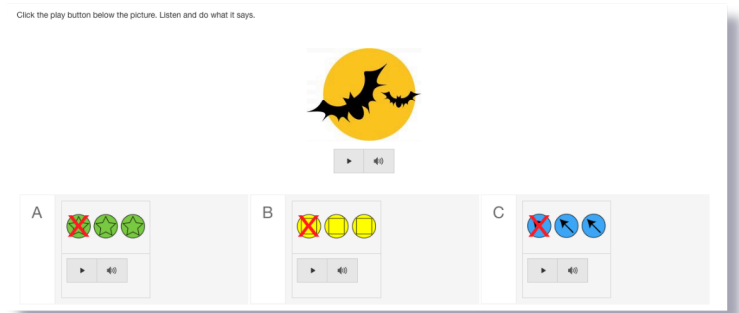

My Galaxies

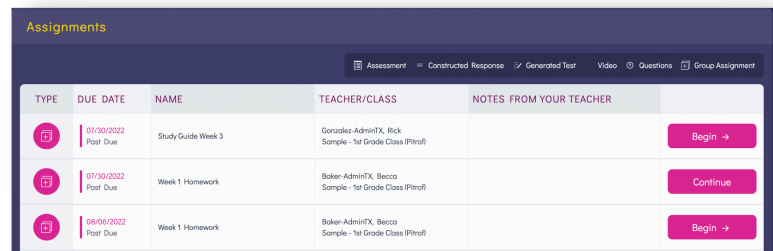
