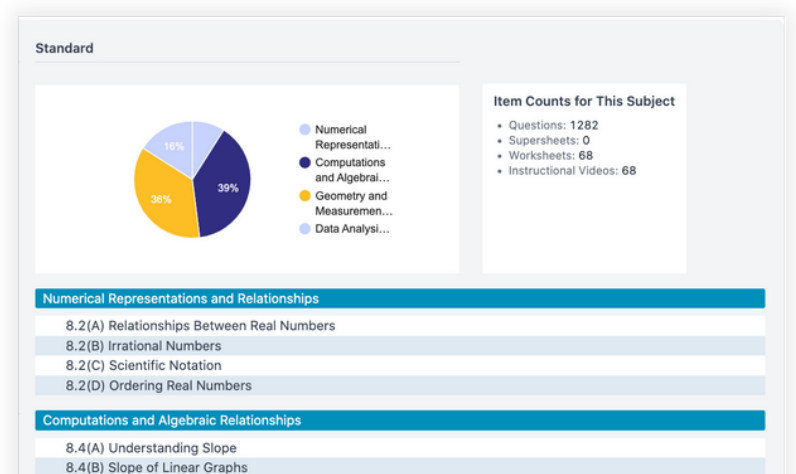


Many high school students have returned from the pandemic school closures in danger of not earning the necessary credits to graduate on time. The need for quality credit recovery is at an all-time high as students need options.

Here are 5 ways Progress Learning can support with Credit Recovery:

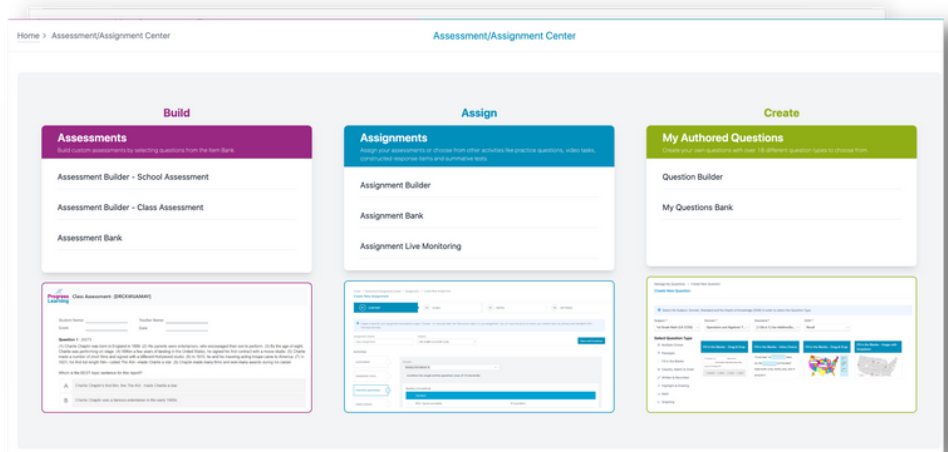
1 Instructional Resources
