Students can develop their language skills with 3 different language modes. Teachers can customize each student's language settings.

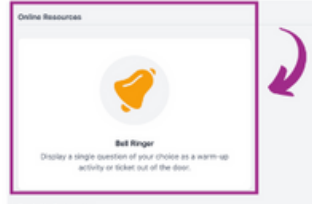
