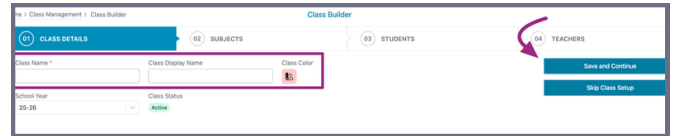


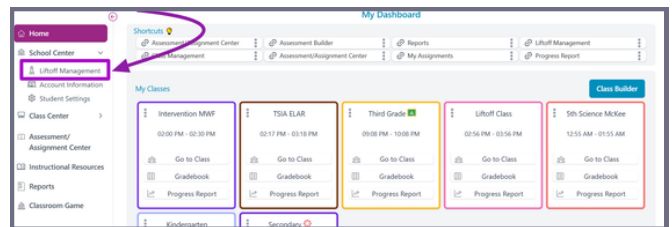
1 Set Up Your Classes

- Organize groups with clear class names and color coding.



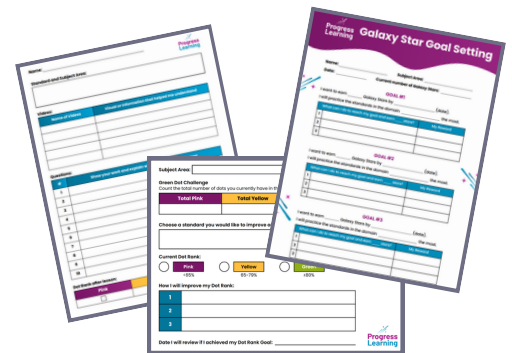
2 Prepare Liftoff for Students

- Customize student settings to support differentiated learning.



3 Use Data to Drive Intervention

- Import **NWEA MAP** MOY scores into Liftoff to begin targeted intervention immediately.
**If MAP data is unavailable, assign diagnostic assessments to establish a baseline.*
- Review student data and set clear learning goals using **student data templates**.
- Monitor progress** weekly with **Liftoff Growth Reports** and review Liftoff and NWEA MAP reports side-by-side.



4 Build Student Engagement

- Launch a Galaxy Star Challenge or Alien Ranking bulletin board to **motivate participation**.
- Introduce Liftoff with **student-friendly videos**.
- Clearly explain how students earn and track mastery.



5 Support Daily Practice & Progress Monitoring

- Review goals with students weekly to keep them focused.
- Use mini-assessments to check for mastery and adjust instruction.
- Track mastery weekly with the Liftoff Galaxy Star Report.
- Reinforce learning with bell ringers and printable resources.
