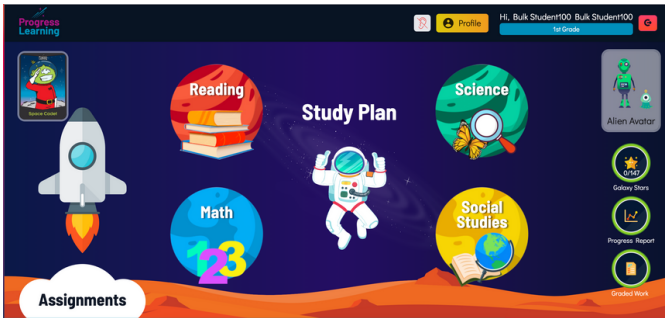


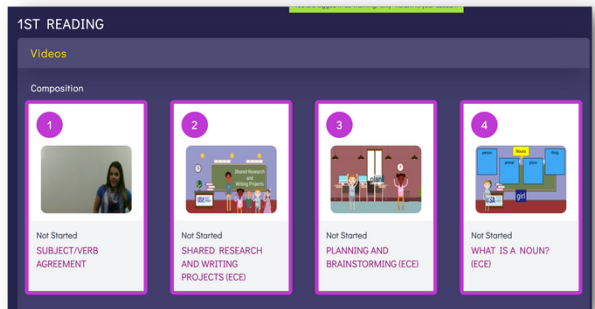
The Science of Reading

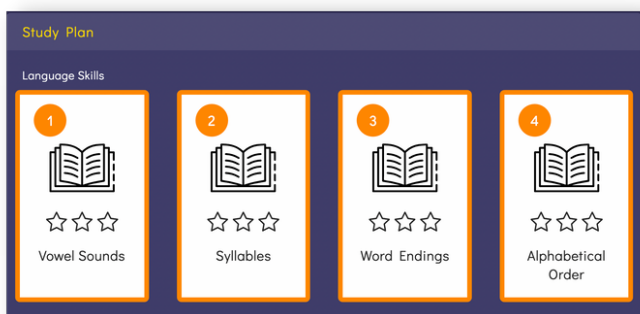

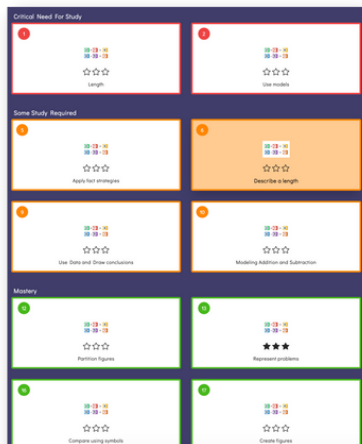
Study Plan
