



# The Green Dot Challenge

## What is the Green Dot Challenge?

The Green Dot Challenge is a way for teachers to individualize a student's learning by breaking down each standard. Through progress monitoring and one-on-one conferences, teachers and students are able to identify areas a student should focus on. Personalized goals are developed, and the student becomes accountable for their own learning.

Students can access their practice from anywhere (even at home) without the teacher having to create an assignment. Through questions and videos, students work at their own pace to increase the number of correct answers and green dots.

## Your Practice Page

You can practice subjects anytime, from home or school, by selecting the "Practice" option on the left menu. Here, you'll see a list of subjects based on what you are currently studying. You can scroll down and click on "Additional Subjects" if you would like to practice content not currently associated with your classes.

- Gray dot: Fewer than 5 questions answered
- Pink dot: < 65%
- Yellow dot: 65-79%
- Green dot: >= 80%

Your practice screen allows you to practice a variety of activities – videos and questions based on the standard you selected.

Try to earn as many green dots as you can! If you don't get a green dot on your first attempt, try again. Remember, your dot color or dot rank is a cumulative score. That means your dot rank is based on all of the activities you have completed for your teacher and on your own. We suggest working in the standards that you have a pink dot in first.

Track your progress with the Practice Progress bar on the right. You'll earn a star when you complete all activities in a standard.
